## BIBLE READING METHOD

**Pray.** This is the starting point. Remember you’re beginning a dialog. Before you read the Bible, ask God to help you understand the passage for the day. God is the author of the Bible and has given it to you to communicate His eternal truth. Ask Him to speak to you as you read.

**Read.** Carefully read the Bible passage for the day. You may find it helpful to read the preceding or following passages to get the context. Take time to read it as thoroughly as you can, expecting God to answer your prayer for understanding His Word.

**Reflect.** This is a key part of the process! Reflect on what you have just read: What does this passage say? What is the main point? What does it reveal about God and about me? What does it require of me now, in thought, word or action? These questions will help you “dig deeper” into the meaning of the passage as you study and reflect. Many people find it helpful to write their answers in a journal or notebook.

**Apply.** God gave us His Word for “teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness” (2 Tim. 3:16). If we are willing, the Holy Spirit will use God’s Word to shape our lives in the direction of greater godliness. Ask yourself this: How can God’s Word apply to my life today; my situations at home, at work, school or church? Your goal is to take what you’ve learned to become more like Jesus.

**Pray.** End in prayer! Thank God for meeting with you and sharing His Word with you. Has your reading revealed a need to confess or surrender anything to God? If so, do it. Ask God to help you live out and apply what you have learned that day.
